

- NZ Secondary School programme as existing in 2015
- NZ Secondary Schools team management personnel recruitment to commence shortly





No longer part of NNZ programmes

- NNZ Talent Development (NZTD)
- NNZ National Development Camp (NDC)





Zone responsibilities

- High Performance/ Performance Squads
 - ANZ Championship Squad
 - Zone Development Squad
- Oversee and assist with Centre Player Development
- Refine position of Zone High Performance Manager
- Oversee Zone talent development
- Oversee Centre entry for U15, U17 and U19 Nationals and other identified competitions
- Competition for Zone Development Squad





Centre responsibilities
