

# NETBALL LEADERS

Growing young leaders through netball

The programme starts with four leadership workshops to build an understanding and knowledge of leadership to complete the **BRONZE** award. Participants then choose a pathway to practice their leadership skills through: netball delivery, coaching or umpiring to complete **SILVER** and **GOLD** awards.

## 1. Netball Delivery Pathway

### GOLD

- Event or programme delivery workshop; and

- a) Assist in delivering a netball tournament at school or a netball centre; or
- b) Assist in developing a netball programme at school or at a netball centre

- a) Leading or playing a lead role in developing or delivering a netball event/tournament at school or a netball centre; or
- b) Volunteer in netball centre delivery for a season.

### SILVER

## 2. Umpiring Pathway

### GOLD

- Introduction to the Rules Workshop or similar
- NNZ Centre Theory Exam Pass (30-minute online test)
- Practical Training Workshop or similar
- Attain NNZ Introduction to Umpiring Award or similar

- Umpiring at a local centre competition (Minimum of 1x 40-minute Year 7/8 game or higher per week for the duration of a winter season)
- Attain NNZ Centre Practical Award
- NNZ Zone Theory Exam Pass

## 3. Coaching Pathway

### GOLD

- 1x Foundation Workshop (Yr 5/6 or Yr 7/8 or similar)
- Introduction to Netball Rules (online)
- NetballSmart (workshop and online module)
- CCA 1 Player Centred Coaching (workshop)
- Assist in coaching at one of the following:  
3x team trainings or 3x PDP sessions; or 1-day tournament

- CCA 1 Planning (workshop)
- CCA 1 Team Culture (workshop)
- CCA 1 Building Effective Relationships (workshop)
- Coach or Co-Coach a Team for a season (any age/grade for the duration of a winter season)
