



## **2017 Super School Invitational Tournament**

Sunday 26th February, B & M Centre, Central Energy Trust Arena, Palmerston North

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **Managers Meeting**

A managers meeting will take place at 9.00am for all teams, managers are asked to convene at the registration desk at this time for a short briefing.

#### **Court Usage**

All courts will be available from 9.00am for teams to warm-up. Courts 2, 4, & 5 will be used for games for the duration of the tournament based in the B & M Centre and the Ball Hall, which are adjacent to each other and easily accessible. During games the courts not in use can be used for warm-ups and cool downs, please be mindful of ongoing games being played on any neighbouring courts and any activity i.e. players, coaches, umpires, officials and spectators.

#### **Team Bench**

Team benches will be positioned on either side of the score bench, the team listed first on the draw will sit to the right of the score bench. Teams are asked to make sure bags and balls are behind the bench and drink bottles are to be kept under the seats while games are being played in the interests of health and safety.

#### **Bench Officials**

Bench officials will be allocated to games subject to availability.

## **Umpires**

Umpires will be allocated to all games during the tournament. Allocations for the Games will be appointed by the NZUDG.

## **First Aid**

All teams are expected to bring their own first aid kit, there will be a central first aid kit and ice available if required, please ask at the registration desk. If an injury occurs, we ask teams complete an injury reporting form available from the registration desk. Please note there will be no physiotherapist on site.

## **Presentations**

A short presentation will take place at the end of the tournament near the registration desk.

## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- All teams must complete a tournament registration sheet prior to the event to register a squad of up to fifteen players, please find attached with this document.
- All teams must complete a team registration sheet and hand this in to the registration desk no later than 20 minutes prior to each game.
- Only twelve players may be registered to take the court in each game (Note: A total of 15 players can play during the tournament).
- All games will comprise of four 8-minute quarters with 2-minute quarter breaks and a 2-minute half time break.
- Injury time will be taken in accordance with the INF rules stated under 9.3 in the Rules of Netball. Timing will be kept centrally for all courts. In the event of an on court injury, time will be taken by the umpire.
- Draws during pool play draws are permissible.
- The following points will be allocated for results during pool play:  
Win = 4  
Draw = 2

Loss (by 3 goals or less) = 1

Loss (by 4 or more) = 0

- If two or more teams are on equal points at the end of pool play a points differential will be used to separate the teams.
