PURPOSE STATEMENT

Netball Central Zone (NCZ) aims to be the pre-eminent netball Zone in the country. Our vision is to produce a home grown Pulse team that wins. We do this by winning pinnacle domestic events and by dominating national selections and age group tournaments.

The purpose of the Assistant Coach Central Manawa role is to support the Head Coach, Central Manawa to develop and implement the Zone's performance plan, specifically regarding the Central Manawa team in the National Beko competition.

The role of the Central Manawa team is to produce Pulse players. This implies identifying talented players, developing their individual skills and building winning team performances.

POSITION

To be eligible for appointment as Assistant Coach, NCZ must be satisfied that the preferred candidate fulfils the following criteria:

- Primary residence is in New Zealand
- Can develop and implement an effective high performance program that grows and supports elite and developing elite players
- Is committed to working with, and achieving the objectives of, the high performance strategic objectives of both NCZ and NNZ
- Demonstrates a commitment to on-going personal development as a coach

The role of Assistant Coach Central Manawa is part-time and appointment will be for a one year term, commencing September 2019, with a review to take place after 12 months. The Assistant Coach Central Manawa position is part of NCZ's High Performance Coach succession planning.
