General Information

ASB Sport Centre

The centre has outdoor and indoor parking facilities free of charge and onsite for teams, umpires and spectators. There are several bathrooms, changing rooms and showers located throughout the ground floor of the facility. Water fountains for use by teams, umpires and spectators are also located on the ground floor. The centre is equipped with free Wi-Fi, users should log on to username 'cbdfree' no password is required. In the event of an evacuation please follow the ASB Sport Centre staff through the main or emergency exits to the designated meeting points. Team Manager Meeting

A team manager meeting for all teams will take place on **Saturday at 9:30am**, attendees are asked to convene at the sports control desk at this time for a short briefing.

Court Usage

Courts 1, 2, 3 & 4 will be used for games on Saturday 15th and courts 3, 4, 5 & 6 on Sunday 16th for the tournament at ASB Sport Centre. The courts on Saturday will be available from 9am for warming up and 8am on Sunday. Teams and umpires are welcome to warm up and practice on their allocated court prior to their games starting. Please vacate your court once your game has finished to allow others access. There is also an outdoor running track around the centre which can be used for warming up if required.

Team Bench

Team benches will be positioned on either side of the score bench, the team listed first on the draw will sit to the right of the score bench. Teams are asked to make sure bags and balls are behind the bench and drink bottles are to be kept under the seats while games are being played in the interests of health and safety.

Bench Officials

We will endeavour to supply bench officials to the games and the Event Coordinator(s) will advise teams if a score bench is available. All teams should be prepared to provide a scorer and/or timekeeper for every game as a contingency. Please advise the Event Coordinator(s) who the scorer and/or time-keeper will be prior to the start of the game. These people must sit away from the team bench as directed by the Event Coordinator to assist the umpires. A score card and timer will be provided.

Umpires

Umpires have been selected for the tournament by the Central Zone NZUDG representatives and will be appointed to games during the tournament. If you have any queries regarding this during the tournament, please contact the sport control desk.

First Aid

All teams are expected to identify a primary care contact for their team and bring their own first aid kit. There will be a central first aid kit and ice available if required at the reception desk. Any major injuries should be reported to the ASB centre staff and the appropriate injury reporting form completed.

Physiotherapist

A physio will be available at the tournament from 9am on Saturday and 8:30am on Sunday, they will be based in the sport control room and access will be on a first come first served basis. The physio will offer strapping, advice and a triage service. This is inclusive of the tournament registration fee.

Netball Smart

The Zone's NetballSmart Development Officer, Lee Spence, will be available during the tournament to help with any recovery needs. Lee will be stationed within the NetballSmart "recovery zone" where he will be available to discuss any topics relating to the NetballSmart principles, including the NetballSmart warm up and how best to recover. In addition, there will be several foam rollers available for use to recover between games.

Post Tournament Recovery

Kilbirnie Aquatic Centre is in close proximity to ASB Sport Centre and offers a range of post tournament recovery facilities i.e. spa, swimming and hydrotherapy pools. Selectors

There will be selectors from the Zone present at the tournament to monitor players for possible inclusion into performance programmes, we ask that players are numbered on both their arms and lower legs to correspond with their number on the team sheet for identification purposes.
